In La Morra, from predominantly marly soils rich in white clay, comes an exceptional Barolo. Harmonious, refined, aromatic, unveiling perfect balance between body and elegance.

Tettimorra distinguishes itself for vivid crimson when young, orange shades appear on older vintages; the nose is fine with traditional licorice, violet and tobacco hints; in the mouth taste powerful and mighty, elegant tannin with prolonged persistence

Maceration on the skins for 23 days in 54 hL wooden vats, with 2 manual pump-overs per day. At the end of the alcoholic fermentation, racking is carried out in steel tanks until the completion of malolactic fermentation.

In 45 hL French Allier oak barrel for a period of 29 months. After bottling, the wine is left to rest for 6 months before being put on the market.

Attractive nose with beautiful cherries, raspberry bush, mild spices and dried orange peel. Vivid and juicy on the medium- to full-bodied palate with firm, dusty tannins and a succulent core of ripe fruit. Bright finish. Better from 2027

Wine Enthusiast – 91

This wine opens with aromas of spiced macerated cherries at the forefront, complemented by an undercurrent of sweet herbs and the matured nuance of tobacco. The palate highlights darker fruits notes and generous dusting of spice, black tea and dried flowers while finishing with a firm tannic structure. Drink 2026 - 2045.

VINTAGE 2019

James Suckling – 92

This is perfumed offering notes of dried cherries, dried orange peel, walnuts and crushed stones. Firm and structured with medium to full body and juicy acidity. Chalky and a little chewy at the end. Drink after 2026.

Wine Enthusiast – 91

Gentian root, wild rose, dried cherries and mélange of spices spill from the glass of this old-school Barolo. On the palate you'll find truffle, macerated raspberry, turned earth and five-spice powder with fine tannins and classic Nebbiolo acidity. Drink 2025 -2045.

VINTAGE 2018

James Suckling – 91

This has aromas of cherries, lemon zest, dried flowers, cranberries and thyme. Bright and tangy, with firm and chalky tannins, a little dusty in nature. Zesty finish. Better from 2025.

VINTAGE 2017

James Suckling – 92

Figs, dried cherries, burnt oranges, walnuts and chocolate here. Ripe and flavorful, with a full body and firm, compact tannins. Dusty cocoa character at the end. Better after 2024.
