A fairly neutral wine with aromas of apricots, seaweed, flowers and peaches. Zesty on the palate, with strong acidity well packed with fruit concentration. Medium-bodied. Biting at the end. From organically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

VINTAGE 2022

James Suckling – 91

A deep and structured red with aromas of blackcurrants, blackberries, toasted spices, black olives, walnuts and cigar box. Full-bodied, smoky and tarry. Really intense, with firm, very tight tannins. Quite an elevated and rich cabernet franc with a lot of extraction and ripeness to its fruit, yet there is balance and form. It should soften after two to three years. Try after 2027.
