The wines of the Morrone della Monica Vineyard come from most easterly location on the foothill of Monte Friento and from the only site that faces due south.

The gradient is more than 30%, so exposure to the sun is fairly strong.

As a result the wines coming from this terroir are full-bodied, generous and intense.

A fine-textured and supple red with aromas of purple berries, wild herbs and warm spices. Medium-bodied with silky tannins. Linear and velvety with a flavorful finish. Drink now.

The 2021 Pallagrello Nero Murella captivates with a bouquet of crushed violets, blood orange, blackberries and animal musk. Silken textures sweep across the palate, contrasted by depths of mineral-infused red and black fruits as grippy tannins slowly saturate toward the close. A bitter tinge of dark chocolate pinches at the cheeks as the 2021 finishes with dramatic length and is structured for the long haul. This formidable Pallagrello Nero is packed with potential, yet patience is necessary.
