Grapes:	Nebbiolo 100%
Vineyard:	Montefico (.24 hectares) in the commune of Barbaresco
Orientation:	Southeast
Soil:	Marl-calcareous
Viticulture:	The Vecchie Vigne selection is made from the oldest vines in the cru – vines over 50 year. Hand-harvested in mid October
Vinification:	Soft pressing with destemming. Fermentation in wood casks. Maceration for 70-90 days
Ageing:	4-6 years in medium-sized French and Slavonian oak casks

The 2019 Barbaresco Montefico Vecchie Viti is a heady, explosive wine. Bright, focused and energetic, the 2019 screams with Montefico character. Crushed rocks, slate, mint, white pepper, dried cherry and chalk are some of the many notes that inform this taut, vibrant Barbaresco. Clean mineral notes extend the finish effortlessly. The Montefico is often one of my favorites in the range. The 2019 is truly special. What a wine!

Firm, bordering on austere even, yet balanced and super long, with an aftertaste of fruit and mineral. Alluring from the get-go, this is accessible despite its firm structure.
