Barolo Rocche di Castiglione 2019

Historical vineyard in Castiglione Falletto, above the Pira geographical mention, next to the winery. The surface area is 0.48ha, and the soil is calcareous clay, rich in white rock and sand.

The plantation dates back to the 1960s and 70s contains wood derived from ancient massal selections.

Ten days fermentatio in large wood casks. They ferment with a pied de cuvee made from their indigenous yeasts. They then use the technique of submerged cap—which can last 60-75 days

The wine is then aged in large neutral French botti. The wine normally ages for 5 years in wood.
