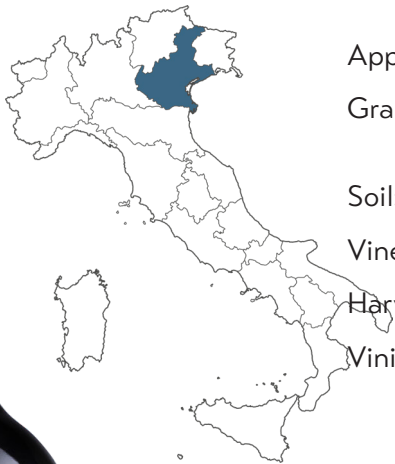




Nicalò

This wine is made from red grape varieties grown on the Moraine Hills in the heart of Valpolicella. The Nicalò Valpolicella DOC Superiore is being released with a new label that embodies the unvarying contemporary and modern style of this Valpolicella Superiore, a faithful representation of an accessible category, perfect for everyday enjoyment.



Appellation:	Valpolicella DOC Superiore
Grapes:	Corvina 35%, Corvinone 35%, Rondinella 20%, Other varieties 10%
Soil:	Red clay and limestone of moraine origin
Vineyard:	20 years (average)
Harvest:	End September – Beginning October
Vinification:	Pressing. Alcoholic fermentation and maceration for 14 days at 28°C
Maturation:	12 months (Slavonian Oak)
Bottling:	6 months bottle ageing
Alcohol:	13,5%
Sugars:	1,5 g/l
Total acidity:	6,1 g/l
Dry Extract:	34 g/l

VINTAGE 2022**James Suckling – 90**

Lush cherries and plums dominate on the nose of this Valpolicella, with hints of bay leaves and pepper. The juicy, medium-bodied palate shows chewy acidity and tight, chalky, crunchy tannins. Savory in the finish. Drink or hold.

VINTAGE 2021**Wine Enthusiast – 91**

Red currants and wild strawberries dance a delicate floral waltz in this fresh and lively Valpolicella. The bright acidity and soft tannins are the perfect partners, creating a delightful and easy-drinking wine that's always ready for a good time.

VINTAGE 2020**James Suckling – 93**

Interesting nutty, sandy, oaky edge to the nose, with an underlay of dried but bright berries. Medium-bodied with sturdy tannins that need a little time to soften, which will add greater breadth and length to the wine. Drinkable now, but this polished Valpo will blossom with another year in bottle and is worth waiting for. Best from 2025.

Wine Enthusiast – 90

Lifted and fresh aromas of macerated cherries, spiced plum, anise and wild herbs define the nose of this Valpolicella. It's giving and generous on the palate with plump mixed berry fruits dusted with cocoa and espresso and finishing with dried leaf and bright acidity.
